Shots Recorded Report



A **Shots Recorded Report** can be created in Florida SHOTS that provides an Excel file of vaccinations recorded corresponding to the VFC PIN, vaccination effort, date range and vaccines. This report provides the "**Shots Recorded**" details available under the hyperlinks for each vaccine type on the "**Florida SHOTS Order Request – Doses Administered And Inventory Levels**" page. This guide will give you the step-by-step instructions to create the report.

STEP 1

Log into Florida SHOTS.


STEP 2

Select "Vaccine Inventory" then "Shots Recorded" from the Florida SHOTS menu.



STEP 3

Select your PIN and click on the "Search" button.



STEP 4

Once the search is completed, you will see the provider information including VFC shipping address and contact. Enter the date range that you would like to search in the "From Date" and "Through Date" fields. Select one or more specified "Vaccines" or "All." To select more than one vaccine type hold the [Ctrl] key down while clicking on the vaccines. Click on "Generate Shots Recorded Report" button.




STEP 5

Click "OK" on the pop-up message advising you that it may take over two minutes to generate.




STEP 6

Click "**OK**" on the additional pop-up message advising you that the Excel file will open in a separate window. Proceed to click "**Open**" on the additional message to open the file.



Once the file opens, there is a tab for each "Vaccine Type" and "Criteria" page (recaps your selection) that you can click on to review.

The report heading format consists of Inv Match, Vaccine Type, Vaccination Date, IMM State ID, Patient Name, Date of Birth, Mfg/Lot, Exp Date and Eligibility.



NOTE: The "Inv Match" field will have an "N" if the "Funding Program" field was completed when the vaccine was entered manually, or uploaded in the patient record. As well as, if the lot number, expiration date, or the manufacturer does not match the current inventory, as it does on the "Florida SHOTS Order Request – Doses Administered And Inventory Levels" page.
