VFC Enrollment Training Guide



INTRODUCTION

The Immunization Section's VFC Annual Provider Staff Training will consist of two of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) "You Call the Shots" interactive, Web-based training courses. The VFC enrollee, primary VFC coordinator, and back-up coordinator must each complete both trainings individually. A CDC TRAIN account must be created to complete the course assessment and evaluation to receive a certificate.

NOTE: Listing additional names or a group on certificates will not be accepted.

Step 1

Go to CDC's "You Call the Shots" Web page by clicking on the link, or typing www.cdc.gov/immunizationtraining/hcp/you-call-the-shots/ in the search engine of your desired Web browser (see image below).

Step 3

Once logged in to CDC TRAIN, select **COURSE CATALOGUE** to search for the course. Enter the course number in the **Search TRAIN** field and click on course to continue.

Step 8

Click on Mark Completed which will prompt to initiate the post-assessment.



Click **OK** to start the post-assessment. You will have two attempts to get a passing score of at least 80%.



NOTE: The course evaluation will be available once the assessment is completed.

Step 10

Once the course assessment and evaluation are completed, close the page to return to CDC TRAIN. The **Certificate** button will now be available to download the certificate.





Repeat STEPS 3 to 10 to complete the second course.
